

Week 1: What is social psychology?

1.1 How is social psychology defined, and how is it similar/ different to other areas of research?

Social psychology can be defined as:

“The *scientific investigation* of how the thoughts, feelings, and behaviours of *individuals* are influenced by the *actual, imagined, or implied presence of others*” (Allport, 1954, p. 5)

Simply put, it looks at social behaviour in a social context.

Scientific investigation:

Applying the scientific method of systematic observation, description, and measurement to the study of the human condition.

Individuals

Sociology typically compartmentalises individuals in terms of their nationality, race, socioeconomic class and other group factors. Conversely, social psychologists emphasise the behaviour of the individual in the group context.

Social context:

Simply imagining receiving positive or negative reactions from others can influence self-esteem.

Implied presence: assigning social meaning to things because of our interactions with others.

1.2 What are levels of analysis (or explanation) and why is it important to social psychology?

All are relevant, but we use the one that aligns with the social situation or outcome we are interested in.

Levels of analysis model (Doise, 1976)

1. Intrapersonal - within individuals
2. Interpersonal - between individuals
3. Intagroup (positional) - dynamics within teams or groups
4. Intagroup (ideological) - between groups, wider society
