

How has 'Working Memory' research enhanced psychologists' understanding of memory? Critically evaluate using ideas and evidence relevant to psychological science. Discuss, using evidence and ideas from psychological science (1500 words).

A key aim of cognitive psychology is to learn about how our brains processing works. Memory is a prime example of the advances in this area, given that memory is now not perceived as merely a store of information. Working memory is all about the processes involved, namely, reasoning, consciousness, and language for example, it is active as opposed to passive. Understanding how these things work allows for a vast array of practical applications, such as cognitive rehabilitation. Working memory is also considered to be an essential tool for diagnosing and aiding children with language problems.

Working memory has substantially enhanced our understanding of memory since there is a large amount of supporting evidence, giving way to a variety of useful applications and is over and above the old storage models. In 1974, Baddeley and Hitch, built upon the early modal ideas of short-term memory proposed by Atkinson and Shiffrin 1968 by teasing apart separate short-term memory mechanisms: the central executive, phonological loop, and visuospatial sketchpad. However, the evidence for these multiple stores of working memory has had its methods questioned by Though Klem et al (2015). Despite this, the idea that there are multiple independent short-term memory stores has allowed explanation for real life issues such as child development, where it was found that some children with comprehension problems actually have working memory problems, not language issues (Cain and Oakhill 1999). This allows for useful wider applications of the knowledge, such as within education and diagnosis, showing us fundamental explanations we would have otherwise not known. These ideas of multiple memory stores were also supported by the case study of KF which illustrated that there are different short-term memory components for verbal information and visual information.

There has been a growing mass of psychological research into the working memory, such as Baddeley and Hitch's 1980 experiment which aimed to explore whether participants could use different areas of their working memory at the same time. The study found that verbal reasoning tasks used the central executive, whilst digit span tasks instead used the phonological loop. This suggest that knowledge of the working memory and being able to use different areas for different tasks could have practical implications in areas such as education, allowing us to me more efficient and learn better and in different ways.

Moreover, working memory is useful for exploring a range of abilities and individual differences. It refers to results from both normal and brain-damaged people, which is an improvement on what previous models have offered. The working-memory model links closely to other areas including awareness, attention, and control. This allows us to look at how memory works in relation to other cognitive processes, offering a much more holistic view of memory with a
