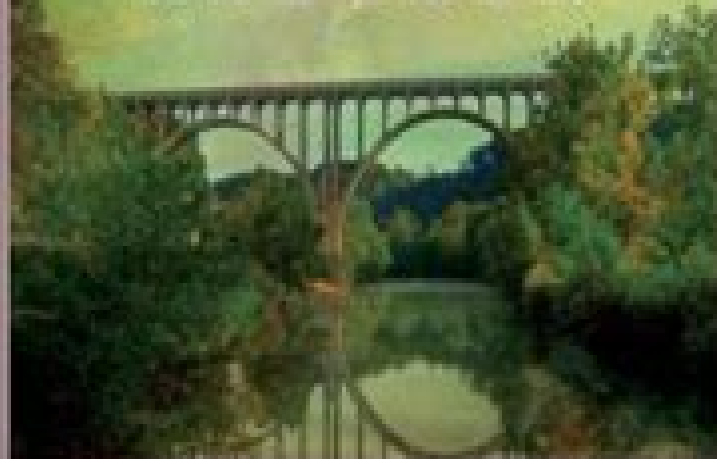

alleged scholasticism in Bavinck's thought are analyzed in terms of their originality and their validity. Regarding the former it is argued that Van Til tacitly appropriates Herman Dooyeweerd's 1894-1977 earlier criticisms of neo-Calvinist scholasticism. Regarding the latter it is argued that Van Til's criticisms are methodologically unsound and historically untenable insofar as they proceed upon subjective premises and lead to a subjective conclusion. In sum, given both his pervasive appropriation of Bavinck's *Dogmatiek* and his entrenchment in neo-Calvinist theology and philosophy, Van Til is more accurately interpreted as a neo-Calvinist rather than a Copernican revolutionary.
