Nkongho, Patrice Levang, This study was carried out in three major palm oil producing areas in Cameroon with the aim of investigating the artisanal milling and commercialization of red palm oil Structured and semi structured questionnaires were administered focus group discussions and participatory observation were applied to obtain required information Those involved were identified and the service providers ranged from mill
