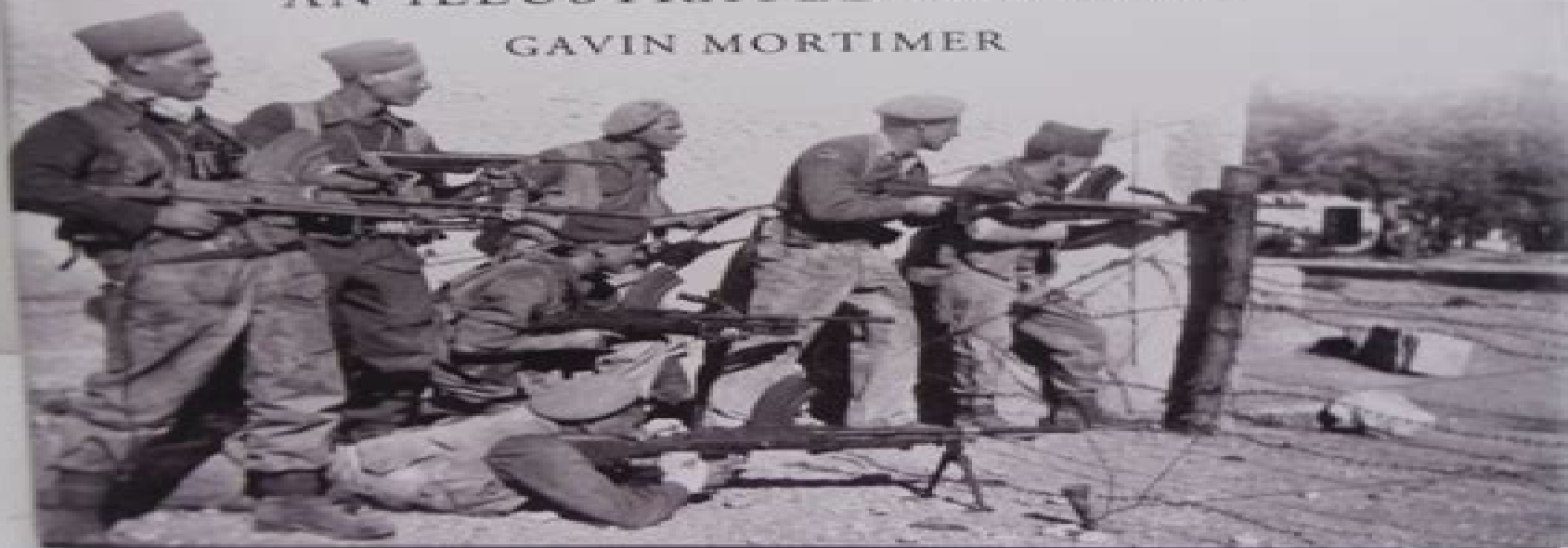

He held numerous public appointments, including President of the Royal Geographical Society, Chairman of the Medical Research Council, President of the SAS Regimental Association, and the UK Cretan Veterans Association.
