#### Reading Comprehension

Millions of years ago, interstellar clouds collapsed to form stars and their solar systems in our Solar System (in fact, this nebular theory is a scientific explanation for the formation of our entire system). In general, the solar system consists of a central star (the sun) and other celestial bodies in our solar system formed from a rotating cloud of gas and dust. This theory was first proposed by the French mathematician and astronomer Pierre Simon Laplace in the 18th century.

176. Within the protoplanetary disk, two distinct regions formed: the inner region closer to the sun, and the outer region farther away.
