1. Process Costing

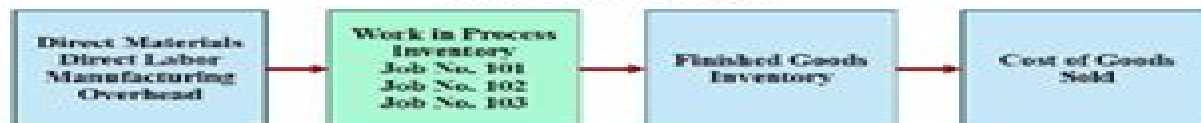
1.1. Definition

- Each unit of product is assigned the same average cost.
