*Vision in Cephalopods* Frederike Diana Hanke, Daniel Colaco Osorio, 2018-03-13 Cephalopods usually have large and mobile eyes with which they constantly scan their environment The eyes of cephalopods are single chamber eyes which show resemblance to vertebrate eyes However there are marked differences such as the cephalopod eye having an everted retina instead of an inverted retina found in vertebrates Their visual system allows the cephalopods depending on species to discriminate objects on the basis of their shapes or sizes images from mirror images or to learn from the observation of others The cephalopod visual system is also polarization sensitive and controls camouflage an extraordinary ability almost
