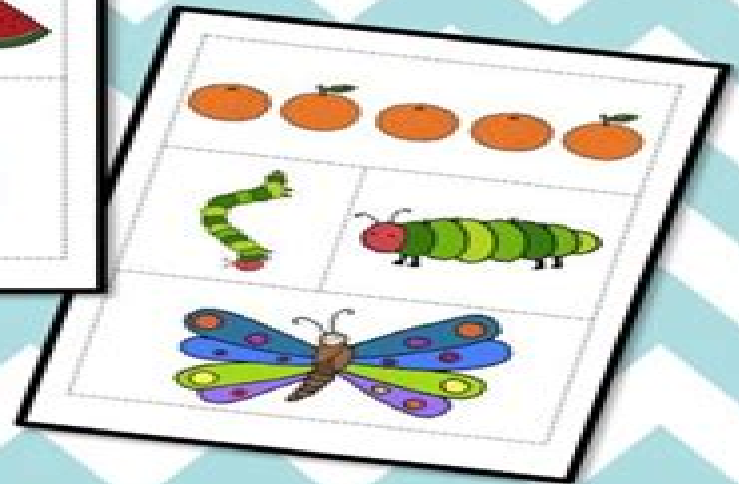
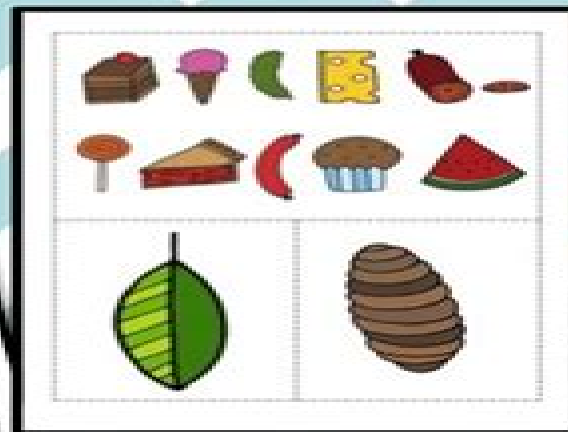
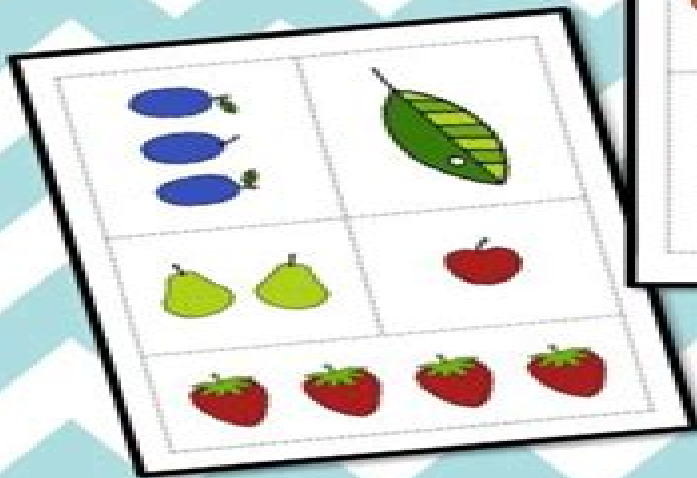

gained a better understanding of how to handle situations effectively Systematic reading for therapeutic purposes can improve coping strategies and help make more informed decisions Reading stories with children can open a safe space teach them that they are not alone provide insight into what is happening around them and offer information that can help them overcome their circumstances Numerous approaches can be used to assist children in dealing with difficult situations One of these can be bibliotherapy a valuable intervention that can help by coping with the effects of a lockdown and paying specific attention to the changed situation It can allow children to face the uncertainty produced by school lockdowns and the inability to see friends and family Bibliotherapy can provide guidance in identifying problems discussing feelings and exploring possible solutions Books have been a tool of change and can assist in making decisions and coping with difficult situations
