The questions in Part 1 are listed for you to think about. They follow, in order, the events of the film. You may wish to take notes as you watch the video.

Part 2, which can be done after you view the video, is a list of things that happen during the story. Some of them seem to be minor incidents, but each one has importance in advancing the plot. Your job is to tell how each event is important to the story.

Biosafety Level 2 (BS2) - Moderate biohazard; infectious agents: hepatitis, Lyme Disease, influenza Biosafety Level 3 (BS3) - High biohazard; multiple vaccinations required; infectious agents: anthrax, typhus, HIV

Biosafety Level 4 (BS4) - Extreme biohazard; maximum security; highly virulent; no known cures or vaccines; infectious agents: Ebola, Lassa, Hanta viruses
