Again, Orczy interweaves historic fact with fiction, this time through the real-life figures of Theresa Cabarrus and Jean Lambert Tallien, inserting the Scarlet Pimpernel as an instigator of the role Tallien played in the Thermidorian Reaction in July 1794. The story starts in Paris in April 1794, year II of the French Revolution. Theresa Cabarrus is a beautiful but shallow Spaniard who is betrothed to Citizen Tallien, the popular Representative in the Convention and one of Robespierre's inner circle.
