URBAN AQUACULTURE INTRODUCTION

Aquaculture is a type of animal-based agriculture that can be practiced in small spaces. It is suitable for city people who want to raise food animals but have limited space to do it. Unfortunately, there is little information about urban aquaculture. This manual was written to give city dwellers information about aquaculture in the city.

This manual provides some basic knowledge about aquaculture. It tells you how to build two different aquaculture systems, a simple recirculating system and an aquaponic system. It also tells you how to maintain these systems and what to do if something goes wrong. Finally, it lists some good places to find out more about aquaculture.

Aquaculture means literally "culture in water". It refers to any crop which is cultured in water. Fish, shrimp, alligator, scorpion, and cat are all examples of aquaculture crops.

A Recirculating System is an aquaculture system where the water is used, cleaned, and then is used again and again.

Aquaponics is a combination of aquaculture and hydroponics. It usually refers to a recirculating system where fish and plants are raised using the same water.
