Why Are So Many Black Men in Prison? Demico Boothe, 2007 African American males are being imprisoned at an alarming and unprecedented rate. Out of the more than 11 million black adult males in the U.S. population, nearly 1.5 million are in prisons and jails, with another 3.5 million more on probation or parole or who have previously been on probation or parole. Black males make up the majority of the total prison population and, due to either present or past incarceration, are the most socially disenfranchised group of American citizens in the country today. This book focuses on the totality of how and why the U.S. prison system became the largest prison system in the world and is filled with relevant statistical and historical references and controversial facts and quotes from notable persons and sources.

So-called tough-on-crime laws, including mandatory minimum penalties and repeat offender statutes, have increased the propensity to punish more offenders with lengthier prison sentences.
