Why Children Die ,2014 This report reviews the evidence on the causes of child mortality in the United Kingdom to inform a suite of policy statements by the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health and the National Children's Bureau. This report highlights the most recently available data on deaths focusing specifically on areas where improved policy and practice could make a difference. It compares causes across age groups across the United Kingdom and constituent countries and with other European countries. Though child and adolescent health has improved dramatically over the past 30 years in United Kingdom many children are still dying from potentially preventable causes. Over half of deaths in childhood occur during the first year of a child's life and are strongly influenced by pre term delivery and low birth weight with risk factors including maternal age smoking and disadvantaged circumstances.
