The Literary World, 1870 **Sensibility** Janet Todd, 2024-05-01 The cult of sensibility jangled the nerves of Europe in the mid-eighteenth century. It touched all literary genres and brought into prominence those qualities of tenderness, compassion, sympathy, and irrational benevolence associated with women by the binary psychology of the time. It privileged spontaneous emotion and found this expressed in the bodily manifestations of tears, fainting fits, flushes, and palpitations. Valuing the pure victim, it took as its archetypes the innocent dying *Clarissa* and the benevolent suffering man of feeling. By the 1770s, as the idea of sensibility was losing ground, sentimentality came in as a pejorative term.
