

# English Research Paper: Overview

## Objective One

**Distributed: Wednesday, February 2, 2011**

**Due: Friday, February 4, 2011**

The English Research Paper is the culminating project and assessment of all the writing, reading, and research techniques you have accumulated throughout the course of the year. This vital and pivotal piece of the curriculum affords an opportunity to demonstrate the ability to read, write, speak, apply knowledge, problem solve, and use a myriad of life skills such as time management, organization, and risk-taking and will occur from March until May. The two (2) components of the project are as follows:

### **Research Paper**

The student will self-select and research a topic in which he/she has an interest. The culmination of the research work is a 1250 word (4-5 text pages) research paper organized around a clearly stated thesis and adhering to standard documentation forms (MLA Handbook) and standard manuscript guidelines. Submitted in the fourth marking period, the research paper and standard manuscript grades will appear in the student's fourth marking period Assessment category of grades. The paper will count for 200 points in the Assessment category. **The paper is due on Friday, April 15, 2011 and must be posted on turnitin.com.**

### **Oral Presentation and Defense**

The student will present his/her project to the class. This is not a reading of the paper but a dynamic presentation of the work using visual aids, constructed models, videos, or any other approved media. The student must interact with the class and teacher during the presentation. The Oral Presentation will take place during the fourth marking period and will be reflected in the fourth marking period Assessment categories of grades. The speech will count for 200 points in the Assessment category. **The presentations will take place from May 17-20, 2011.**

### **Note**

In order for this process to be a successful learning experience, this Objectives Packet enables the student to approach this project in a measured way, with each component having a separate due date. Language, research, speaking, and writing assignments given to students during the course of the semester afford opportunities to practice and to perfect further the skills necessary to successfully meet the objectives required to successfully complete the research paper. Students and parents should note that students and their families can locate information, extra copies, and models for all of the needed research requirements on our class website.

Although we will have many opportunities to visit the library in school and to work on writing during class, students are expected to work independently at home and during study halls, if needed. Please also consider that academic programs will still be occurring; therefore, students should manage their time wisely in order to prepare for quizzes, exams, and other academic responsibilities that may be unrelated to the research project.
