## I. Methods of Testing Memory

- A. **Free Recall**: producing a response, as you do on essay tests or short answer tests
  - 1. Doesn't always give the full scope of what the subject actually remembers
- B. **Cued Recall**: receiving significant hints about the material
- C. **Recognition**: giving several options and choosing the right one among them
- D. **Savings**: compares the speed of original learning to the speed of relearning
- E. **Implicit Memory**: an experience influences what you say and do even though you might not be aware of the influence
  - 1. Reading or hearing a word temporarily results in **priming** that word and increases the chance that you will use it yourself.
- F. **Memories**
  - 1. **Procedural Memories**: memories of how to do something
  - 2. **Declarative Memories**: memories we can readily state in words

## II. Information Processing

- A. **Short-Term Memory**: temporary storage of recent events
- B. **Long-Term Memory**: relatively permanent store of memory
  - 1. **Semantic Memory**: memory of principles and facts
  - 2. **Episodic Memory**: memory for specific events in your life
    - a) More fragile than semantic
  - 3. **Source Amnesia**: forgetting when, where, or how you learned something
- C. **Consolidation**: converting short-term memory into long-term
- D. **Working Memory**: system for working with current information
  - 1. **Central Executive**: governs shifts of attention

- A. **Encoding**
  - 1. Emotional arousal enhances memory encoding.
