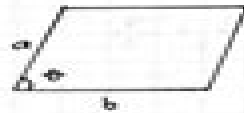


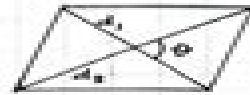

$$A = \frac{1}{2} d_1 d_2 \sin \theta$$



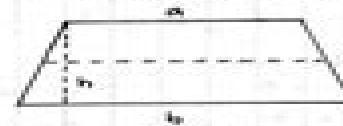

- a parallelogram whose length of the sides are equal

### Trapezoid

- a quadrilateral whose one pair of opposite sides (called bases) are parallel to each other

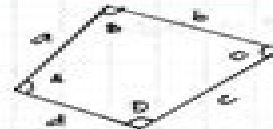


$$\text{median} = \frac{1}{2}(a+b)$$
