The working memory model (VMMI) was developed by Baddeley and Hitch (1974) as they believed the STM has multiple stores. The WMM consists of separate stores for processing acoustic and visual information, which are controlled by the central executive (C.E). The function of the C.E is to manage and direct attention to incoming data and makes decisions and allocates the slave systems to task. The central executive has a limited capacity. The phonological loop (P.I) deals with auditory information and the order of information. The phonological loop contains the phonological store which holds the words you hear and the articulatory process which allows for maintenance rehearsal of acoustic information and has a limited capacity. The visuo-spatial sketchpad is used for the planning of spatial tasks and is a temporary storage for both visual or spatial tasks. The visuo-spatial sketchpad (V.S,S) contains the visual cache which stores information on visual items and the inner scribe which deals with spatial relationships whilst storing the arrangements of objects in the visual field and has a limited capacity. The episodic buffer has a limited capacity. It integrates information from the c.e. p.l and v.s.s. maintaining a sense of time sequencing-recording events that are happening.

One strength of the WMM comes from dual-task studies. This is because Gathercole and Baddeley found that when PPT were given a simultaneous task of following a moving point of light and describing the angles on the letter 'F', they found it more difficult than when they were asked to follow a moving point of light while carrying out a verbal task. This was because both tasks require the use of visuo-spatial sketchpad, which has limited capacity meaning it can not deal with these two tasks at the same time. Therefore, this supports the view that the slave systems have a limited capacity as two similar tasks cannot be completed easily, which means it is high in validity.

One strength of the WMM is supporting evidence from brain-damaged patients. This is because Shallice and Warrington found that aspects of KF's STM forgetting of auditory information was much greater than his forgetting of visual information. Therefore, his brain damage appeared to be restricting his phonological loop and not his visuo-spatial sketchpad. This supports the idea of a separate component for auditory and visual information, meaning the WMM is reliable.

A weakness of using case studies of brain-damaged patients is that the process of brain injury is traumatic. This is problematic because this may in itself change
