models and ii developing an importance sampling method that can be used to produce high solution quality with few scenarios Finally we design an approximate dynamic programming model that gives close to optimal solutions to the classic and thus far unsolved portfolio choice problem with constant relative risk aversion preferences and transaction costs given many risky assets and a large number of time periods
