This requires restructuring enterprise work and energy use once again with an even greater emphasis on economic freedom, social mobility and political contestability. Neither transition is automatic. The handful of economies that made speedy transitions from middle to high income status have encouraged enterprise by disciplining powerful incumbents, developed talent by rewarding merit and capitalized on crises to alter policies and institutions that no longer suit the purposes they were once designed to serve.
